This is an art class - creativity is required.

This is school - learning and demonstrating what you've learned are required.

This is a shared learning environment – active listening, close observation, direction following, cooperation and complying with classroom rules are all required.

Although there is very little time required outside of class, assignments will require that you work diligently the full 40 minutes of every class period.

Effective use of class time is a significant portion of your grade!

 The classroom is equipped with iMacs, scanners, professional printers, drawing tablets and other electronic devices. School cameras, as well as other photography equipment, are available to borrow.

Users of in-class equipment will be held responsible for any damage to classroom property due to careless or reckless behavior.

Borrowers are responsible for the equipment on loan to them and will be required to pay for any damage or loss of equipment due to negligence/carelessness.

Students may sign-out various electronic devices from the school to use for class assignments. Devices must be returned the following day or as arranged with Mrs. Grower. In case of a substitute teacher, students are to hold on to borrowed equipment until Mrs. Grower returns –equipment must not be left in the room or with a sub! Cameras and camcorders must be recharged and images deleted when returned. Memory cards, batteries, chargers and cables must all be returned with devices. Failure to return equipment in a timely manner will result in the loss of borrowing privileges.

The purpose of the computer network is to support the educational activities of the School District. <u>All</u> use of the network and technology resources <u>must</u> be in support of education and research (Student-Parent handbook, Section V. – Board of Education Policies: <u>Acceptable Use Policy for Network and Internet Access</u>).

Instructions for formatting and saving designs will be given the first weeks of school and should be followed throughout the year.
