Rank/GPA

Final rank is determined at the end of the first semester of the student's senior year. It includes all high school courses taken. In calculating class rank, an index is applied to the final grade to reflect degree of course difficulty. Rank is weighted. GPA is unweighted.

Holland Patent High School graduates on average around 100 students a year and has a 4-year graduation rate of 93%.
