New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law

• S 1225-d. **Use of portable electronic devices**. 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, no person shall operate a motor vehicle while using any portable electronic device while such vehicle is in motion; provided, however, that no person shall operate a commercial motor vehicle while using any portable electronic device on a public highway including while temporarily stationary because of traffic, a traffic control device, or other momentary delays. Provided further, however, that a person shall not be deemed to be a commercial motor vehicle while using a portable electronic device on a public highway when such vehicle is stopped at the side of, or off, a public highway in a location where such vehicle is not otherwise prohibited from stopping by law, rule, regulation or any lawful order or direction of a police officer.

New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law

What is a portable electronic device?

Any hand-held mobile telephone, PDA, handheld device with mobile data access, laptop computer, pager, broadband personal communication device, two-way messaging device, electronic game, or portable computing device, or ANY OTHER electronic device when used to input, write, send, receive or read text for present or future communication.

1225-d 4- A person who holds a portable electronic device in a conspicuous manner while operating a motor vehicle on a public highway including while temporarily stationary because of traffic, a traffic control device, or other momentary delays is presumed to be using such device.

- Negative Driving History
- Increase in insurance premiums
- Court Fines & Surcharges
 - Fines as of July 26, 2013
 - 1st offense \$50 \$150
 - 2nd offense \$50 \$200
 - -3^{rd} offense \$50 -400
 - Surcharge of up to \$93
 - Total Cost \$143 \$493

- Points on your license (First offense you receive 5)
 - 11 points in an 18 month period may cause your license to be suspended
 - If operating with a Class DJ or MJ license
 - First conviction will result in suspension of license or permit for 60 days
 - Second conviction will result in revocation for at least 60 days

Texting while driving does not necessarily only lead to a texting ticket...

- VTL 1180, SPEEDING
- VTL 1172, FAIL TO OBEY A STOP SIGN
- VTL 1129A, FOLLOWING TOO CLOSELY
- VTL 1110A, FAILURE TO OBEY A TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE
 ETC...

Additional driving infractions mean more money, more points, and a greater chance for suspension and revocation of your driving privilege.
