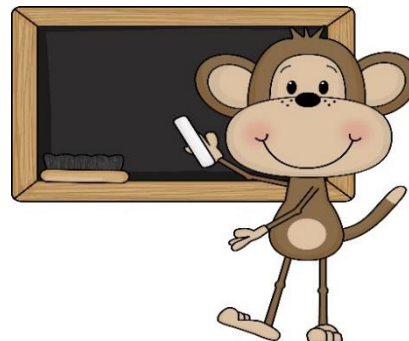


First Grade Sight Words



SIGHT WORDS are words that appear frequently in text and are often difficult to decode as they do not follow common rules for solving unknown words. They may also be words that belong to a word family such as he, she, be. We will be learning these words and students will be expected to read and spell **SIGHT WORDS** quickly and accurately. We encourage you to spend some time and become familiar with these words.

*Make and play a memory game with the words

***Write them on index cards and have your child practice them when they are traveling in the car, waiting at a restaurant, dentist appointment, etc.....**

***FIND THE WORDS IN A NEWSPAPER OR MAGAZINE AND CIRCLE OR HIGHLIGHT THEM.**

***WRITE THEM IN SHAVING CREAM, PUDDING, OR SALT ON A COOKIE SHEET.**
