- 155.3 = Comprehensive Public School Safety Program
- 155.4 = Building Inspections
- 155.5 = Uniform Safety Standards for School Construction and Maintenance
- 155.7 = Health and Safety in Existing Educational Facilities

Safety Drills

Fire Drills - Building

- Mandated = 8 (Scenario Based)
- Additional
 - During Construction Projects

Fire Drills – Buses

- Mandated = 3

Lockdown Drills

- Mandated = 4 (Law Enforcement Support)
 - Evaluate, Critique, Adjust

***Any combination of fire and lockdown drills = 8 completed by December 31st**

Additional Enhanced Procedures



- Single-Point/Supervised building entry points upon student arrival
- Exterior/Interior doors = Locked at all times
- New Employee Training
- Surveillance
- Law Enforcement Drills/Trainings/Sweeps
- Law Enforcement have access to floor Plans / building Plans
- Pre/Post trip Bus Inspections
- Transportation / Grounds Sweep
- School Messenger
