PROGRESS REPORTS

THE MARKING PERIOD GRADE

The final marking period grade is composed of the following categories:

- **15%** 10 Week Exam
- **30%** Tests, Major assignments, Projects, Presentations, and Required writing pieces (corrections can be made to raise test grades)
- **25%** Effort (preparedness, responsibility, conduct, listening and following directions, etc.)
- 30% Class Work/Homework
