What we are learning in the month of November:

ELA: This month we will continue focusing on reading text closely and having students compare and contrast the similarities and differences among some of the stories we have read. We will talk about how the themes of stories may be connected among texts. We will also focus on newly learned vocabulary words from the stories that we read.

Math: We will be learning to solve division problems using factors of 2 and 3. Students will use arrays and tape diagrams to help them model, compare and analyze division problems. They will also be using multiplication and division using factors of 4. The distributive property and problem solving using factors of 2-5 and 10 will also be taught.

Science/SS:

In science we will be learning all about the weather. We will be discussing the different types of weather tools and how they are utilized to predict the weather. We will also be viewing weather maps and identifying basic weather trends based on geographic location.
