- Instrument Petting Zoo Assistant (June 3, 2020)	15
- Participation in an extracurricular ensemble (Jazz Ensemble, String Ensemble, Vocal Ensemble, Chamber Ensemble, Knightly Players)	10 per group
- Participation in an honors ensemble (All-County, Area All-State, Symphoria Youth Orchestra, etc.)	10 per ensemble
- Music Mentoring Program	10 per session
- Community Outreach Concert Performance (Nursing Home Performance, recitals, etc.)	10
- Hallway Caroling on December 20	10
- Performing National Anthem at sporting event	10
- Volunteering at NYSSMA Majors (June 3-4, 2020)	10 per day
- Attending an outside concert (Bring program/ticket as proof)	5
- Assisting a music teacher during a free period/after school	5 per period
- Concert Usher/Concert Concessions/Concert Set Up	5
- Sell Hershey's chocolate	5 points per box (max 25 points)
